On July 22, 2024, Gregory S. Miller, 93 of Hamilton, beloved husband of 67 years of Carol Ann Porter, who predeceased him in April 2024. He was the beloved father of Timothy (Stacy), Terrence (late wife Deborah), Margaret, Kathleen (Greg), Erin (Ron) and Brian (Jenny). Also survived by 10 grandchildren, 7 great grandchildren, one brother, 3 sisters-in-law, numerous nieces, nephews, great-nieces, great-nephews, cousins and friends.

Greg was a 1948 graduate of Allegany High School in Cumberland, Md. He lettered in basketball and track and field and ran a 4 minute mile in his senior year. He was a percussionist in the school Marching Band and Orchestra.

In his late teens and early twenties, when there was a large fire in Cumberland, Greg's father, Herman J. Miller, a Captain in the Cumberland City Fire Department would call home and tell Greg to come to the scene of the fire to help. He always enjoyed helping as he wanted to be a firefighter since he was a little boy.

Before moving to Baltimore in 1963, Greg was a fire fighter for the Washington DC Fire Department as well as the Oxon Hill VFD.

Greg served in the US Navy during the Korean War, earning the National Defense Medal. He was Honorably discharged in 1954.

He was a Traffic Engineer with the State Highway Administration for 33 years, retiring in 1996.

Greg was an Usher during Sunday Mass at St. Dominic in Hamilton for 25 years. Greg was an avid reader, history buff and enjoyed music.

The family will receive family and friends on Monday July 29th from 10 am to 11 am at St. Isaac Jogues Church 9215 Old Harford Rd., Parkville. A Mass of Christian Burial will be held at 11 am at the church. Interment immediately following at Dulaney Valley Memorial Gardens.
