Thomas Moran Carolan, Jr. passed away on July 9, 2023, he is survived by his son Tom Carolan and daughter Page Wilkins, four grandchildren and ex wife Katie Carolan.

Born June 10, 1952 in Baltimore, Md, he graduated from Mt. St Joe. in 1970 and Towson State in 1974.

He had a long career in commercial and residential construction before founding his own business, Apple Tree Homes in the late 1980s. The firm built thousands of homes across Maryland: from single family developments to high end custom homes during 30 plus years of operations.

He also served as the operations manager for the Special Olympics of Maryland for several years in the 1990s.

From college on he loved rugby playing for the Towson team and the Chesapeake Oldboy's club. Later taking to golf as his favorite. He coached little league and even youth hockey for a stint when a fill-in was needed. He grew up a rabid Baltimore colts and orioles fan with his father, also Thomas Carolan, passing the fandom down to his son Thomas when the Ravens came to town.
